DITP advises you to conduct basic credibility check on your new trade counterpart



Genuine exporter/manufacturer?



(www.dbd.go.th)



a business registered with DBD | O check website with Scamaviser | (www.scamadviser.com)



physical address is valid (you may check on Google map)



land-line telephone number must be available and valid (BKK landline always begins with +662-XXX-XXXX)



- check website information
 - photos of company/factory
 - photo and name of management team
 - photo of products matched company name/brands
 - available both in English and Thai



corporate email address shows greater credibility than @gmail, @yahoo, @hotmail, etc.

Be calm and cautious

- suspect offers that come out of the blue or deals that seem too good to be true
- ignore pressure to make payment especially when important information is withhold
- do not make big or full amount of advance payment/deposit
- avoid bank transfer, instead open L/C
- check receiver's bank account
 - ✓ name matches company, not a "personal" account
 - ✓ branch in the same area with company address

If you have been scammed...

what action should you take?



gather all evidence related to the case (commercial documents, money transaction, etc.)

take legal actions

- get documents legalized by consular authorities
- appoint a legal representative in Thailand
- authorize your legal representative to press charge on such fraudulent individual at the police station in Thailand
